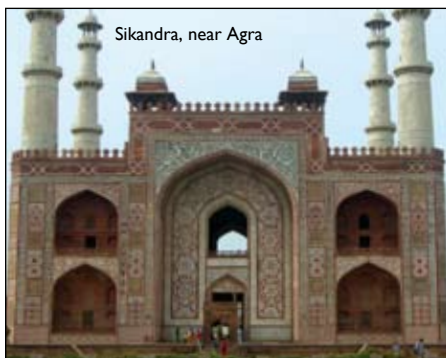

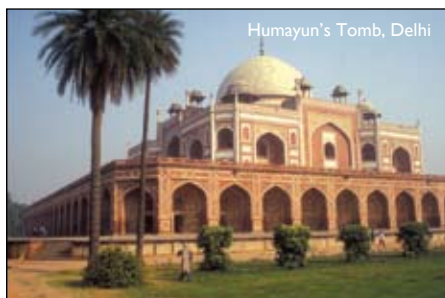

PUSHKAR CAMEL FAIR

The Pushkar Camel Fair is one of the largest and most colorful and interesting fairs in India. Tens of thousands of people from rural India flock to Pushkar, along with Camel and Cattle for several days of live stock trading, pilgrimage and religious festivities. This small town becomes full of life with colorfully dressed devotees, musicians, acrobats, folk dancers, traders, comedians, Sadhus and tourists. Devotees take dips in the holy Pushkar lake. Camel decoration, camel races and camel judging competitions and acrobats have crowds to cheer. Each evening brings different folk dances and music of Rajasthan, performers delivering live shows to the roaring and applauding crowds.



UDAIPUR

Romantic Lake Pichola, Udaipur

The city of Udaipur, is perhaps the most romantic city in India. Udaipur is an inspiration for the imagination of poets, painters and writers. It's a kaleidoscope of fairy-tale palaces, hills, lakes, temples, gardens and narrow lanes strewn with stalls. The imposing City Palace towering over the Lake Pichola is the largest palace complex in Rajasthan.

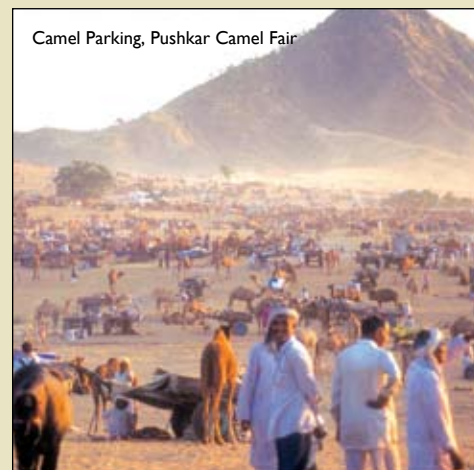
