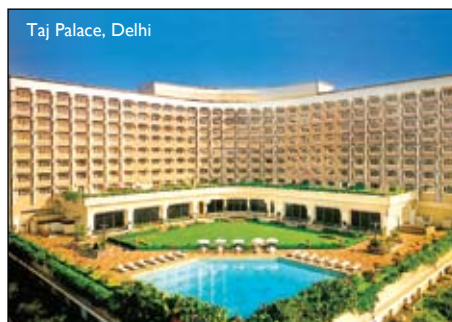

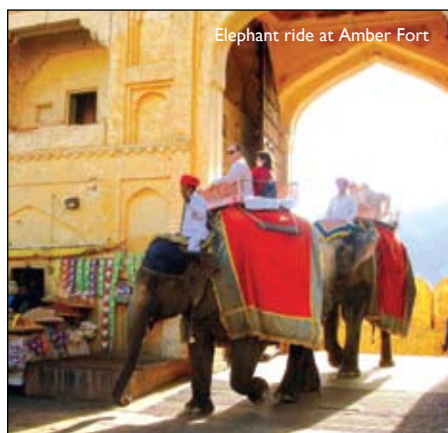
## AN ARTFUL JOURNEY

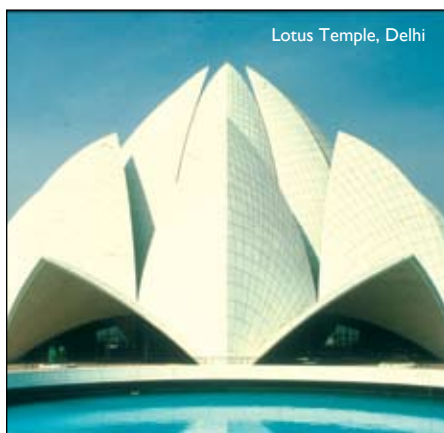
## A JOURNEY INTO THE PEOPLE AND CULTURE OF INDIA
